

Coronavirus (Covid-19) May 29, 2020 Update

As you know, on Thursday Mayor Lightfoot announced that the City of Chicago will move into Phase 3 named “Cautiously Reopen” on June 3, 2020. Accordingly, EIT will take a careful approach to reopening the Fund Office for business to ensure the health, safety and well-being of our participants and team members. In order to comply with the guidelines set forth by the City under Phase 3, most EIT team members will continue to work remotely during Phase 3.

The Fund Office will operate under the following guidelines until further notice:

- Walk-in visitors are not allowed unless they are dropping off documents. All documents will be placed in the mail slot as directed by signage.
- If you wish to meet in person with an EIT team member, you must make an appointment. Facial coverings and proper social distancing are required during the meeting.
- The 221 N LaSalle building has implemented certain Covid-19 restrictions for accessing and moving around the building.
